Smoke Alarms Save Lives

Working Smoke Alarms double your chances of surviving a fire

Replace all smoke alarms that are over 10 years old

Install one alarm on every storey and outside of sleeping areas



Beware of Carbon Monoxide

Install if you have a fireplace, attached garage or gas/propane appliances

Digital Readout alarms monitor and display CO concentrations



ABC's of Fire Extinguishers

Install on every floor; one per 600 sq. feet of living space

BC-rated for kitchens and electrical; ABC-rated for wood and general use



Practice An Escape Plan

Plan two ways out from every room if possible and practice them with your family
